It is the policy of Ash Villa School not to charge parents, carers or students for any provision or activity offered by the school. This applies to:

Examination Fees

Whilst the fee for entering students for examinations will be met by their main educational provider, for those who are single-rolled at Ash Villa School the school will cover the cost of all examination entries.

School Meals

The students eat meals provided by the Ash Villa Inpatient Unit during the school day, including packed meals when off-site.

All Activities That Take Place During School Hours

There is no charge for activities during school hours. There is no charge for transport during school hours to school-organised activities that take place off-site.

As no charges are made by Ash Villa School there is no requirement for consideration of remission of charges.

Damage to Property and Breakages

Where school property has been wilfully damaged by a student or parent the school may charge those responsible for some or all of the cost of repair or replacement.

Where property belonging to a third party has been damaged by a pupil, and the school has been charged, the school may charge some or all of the cost to those responsible. Whether or not these charges will be made will be decided by the Headteacher and dependent on the situation.
